## Start the school year safe online

- 1. Check the basics
  - Use App Store settings to only show age appropriate apps.
  - Check that app and in-app purchasing requires a password.
  - Turn off 'location services' so that your child doesn't unintentionally share their location with others.
- 2. Review apps on their devices
  - Check age ratings of any unfamiliar apps (use www.net-aware.org.uk)
  - Check their privacy settings across all gaming, social and messaging apps
- 3. Switch on safe search use Google Safe Search and YouTube restricted mode
- 4. Check your connections
  - Use parental controls on your broadband and a content lock on their mobile network
- 5. Agree digital boundaries
  - Talk about how to be responsible and stay safe online when sharing images or live streaming
  - Stay engaged by having regular conversations about what they do online.

## School Uniform at Millbank Academy from September 2017

At Millbank Academy pupils wear the agreed school uniform to promote a sense of belonging and identity. We want our pupils to always look smart and to follow our uniform code. We want to teach our children to take pride in their appearance and to represent Millbank Academy to the highest standards.

Please keep the school uniform in a clean state and in good repair.

#### All clothing, bags and shoes must be marked clearly with the owner's name.

#### Shoes

Shoes must be **plain** black. Shoes with flashing lights are <u>not</u> suitable for school. If your child is unable to tie their own shoes laces, we ask that they wear shoes with Velcro or buckles. <u>Boots are not suitable.</u>

#### Socks

Socks should be grey or white without pattern or decoration. Girls can wear **red or grey tights** in the winter.

#### Make up

Make up and nail varnish are not permitted at school.

#### **Jewellery**

Pupils with pierced ears may wear a single pair of stud earrings. Pupils may wear a small plain watch. No other jewellery is allowed. The school does not take responsibility for missing items of jewellery.

#### Hairstyles

Millbank Academy expects pupils to have reasonable hairstyles and colours. Long hair should be tied back. If children wear hair bands or hair ties they must be plain red, black or white. Hair bands should be small plain and functional. Pupils should not have patterns cut/shaved into their hair. If girls wear a headscarf for religious reasons it should be plain and dark (in school colours), tucked into the collar.

Please note that any pupils who arrive at school wearing incorrect school uniform will result in the parent being notified and instructed to rectify this by the following day.

You should have all received your one free jumper/cardigan and tie.

Once our ordering system is in place we will let you know so you can purchase additional items.
