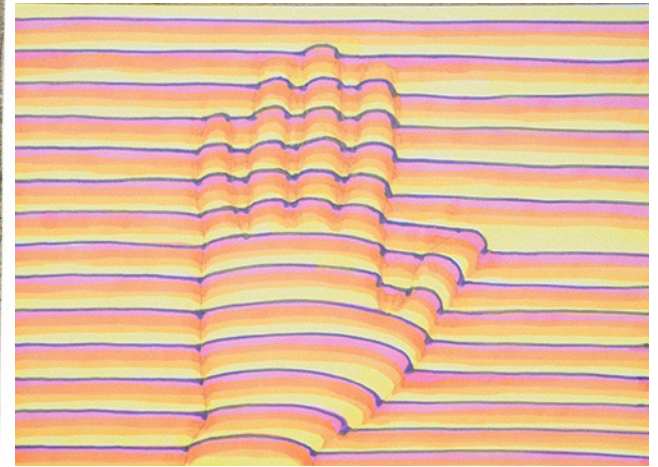

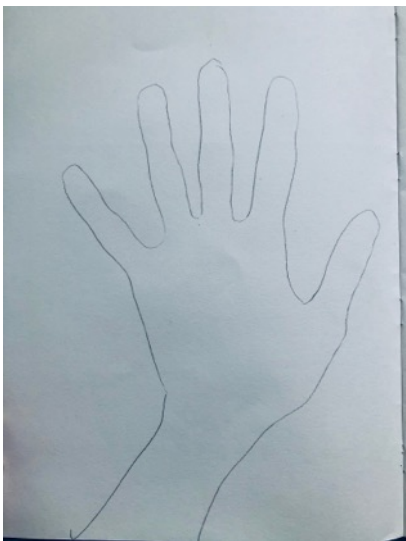
What is similar and what is different between these two drawings? Consider how the artists have used line in their work.



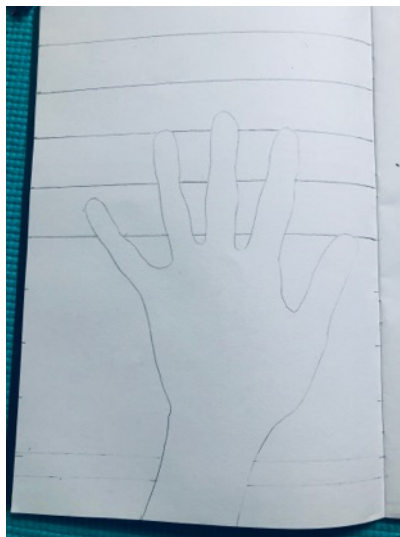

Learning objective: To explore how line can be used to show the form of the human body

You will need: A4 paper, ruler, pencil, rubber, a selection of felt tip pens (colouring pencils can be used if you don't have these).



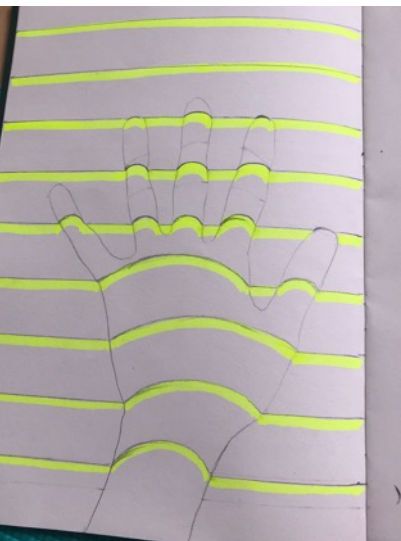
Step one:
Draw around your hand on the A4 paper. Make sure your wrist comes off the edge of the page.



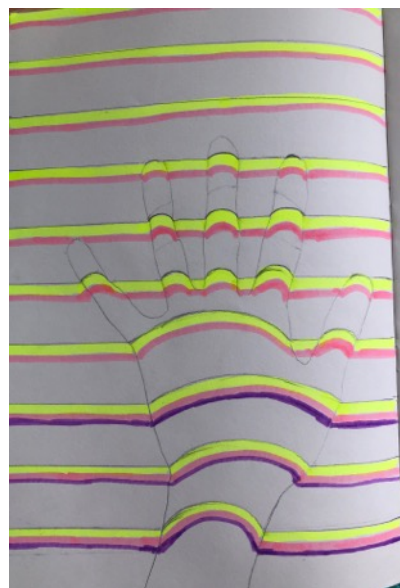
Step two:
Measure and mark every 3cm of your page. Draw a straight line across your page (not over the hand).



Step three:
Join up the empty spaces on your hand by drawing an arc (rainbow shape) each time there is a gap. This has to be done for each space separately.



Step four:
With a felt tip follow underneath the straight and curved lines across the page. Do this carefully and slowly.



Step five:
Continue repeating this with different colours. You might want to think about creating a pattern with your colours. Until your page is completely full.

Step six:
Fill up your whole page and you will be complete!
