

Evidencing the impact of the Primary PE and Sports Premium Sports Premium Funding Report 2019 – 2020

What is the Sports Premium funding?

The Government is providing funding to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools. OFSTED will play a significant role in ensuring that schools target this funding in areas, which will lead to clear outcomes in raising standards and opportunities in PE and school sport for all children throughout the Primary Phase. Millbank Academy received £18,860 in the school year 2019/2020.

Purpose of funding

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, through:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- new or additional sport clubs
- paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing participation in school games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE/sport
- providing places for pupils in after school sport clubs and holiday clubs.

Millbank Academy uses the funding to:

- Buy exciting and stimulating resources to facilitate the teaching of PE (£1,000)
- Run inter-school sports competitions (£500)
- Entry into Westminster sports hub and related costs (£3000)
- Provide coaching before and after-school from a sports specialist (£3384)
- Saturday Sport (£500)
- Provide swimming in the Summer term for Y4 (£2914) (Unable to complete due to covid19)
- Subsidies active before and after-school clubs (£3500) and Saturday Sport (£500)
- Increase the skill level of staff in the delivery of quality P.E. teaching through external CPD (£800) employing a specialist PE coordinator to support the school sports coach (£2796) and sharing ideas that can be used inside the classroom through internal CPD
- Have sports coach available at lunchtimes to facilitate more physical activity (£3200)

Impact of the funding: (Due to Covid closure, this has been restricted)

- We have a high take-up of sports clubs and after school activities often with a waiting list
- We have successfully participated in sports competitions up to the school closure
- Swimming unable to happen in summer term due to COVID19
- Before school coaching sessions are always fully attended
- All teachers involve their classes with the daily mile (or alternative)
- Teachers adapt PE to classrooms to allow for PE even during periods of poor weather.
